What is Bitcoin

Bitcoin is a virtual currency, independent and decentralized, since it is not controlled by any state, financial institution, bank or company.

It is an intangible currency, although it can be used as a means of payment just like physical money. As stated in the document "**Currency or Virtual Currencies: The Case of Bitcoin**", drawn up by the Directorate-General for Operations, Markets and Payment Systems "**virtual currencies**", including **Bitcoin**, "**constitutes a heterogeneous set of innovative payment instruments that, by definition, lack a physical support to support them**".

The term **Bitcoin** originated in 2009, when it was created by Satoshi Nakamoto (pseudonym of its author or authors), who created it with the aim of being used to make purchases only over the Internet.

The same document that we referred to earlier by the Bank of Spain expands this objective: "**Bitcoin was born with high ambitions: to provide citizens with a means of payment that makes it possible to execute fast, low-cost value transfers and that, moreover, cannot be controlled or manipulated by governments, central banks or financial institutions**."

The virtual currency uses cryptography to control its creation. The system is programmed to generate a fixed number of **Bitcoins** per unit of time through computers called miners. Currently, that number is set at 12.55 **Bitcoins** every ten minutes, although it is programmed to halve every 4 years.

Starting in 2020, 6,275 **Bitcoins** will be issued every ten minutes. Production will continue until the year 2140, when the maximum of 21 million units in circulation is reached.

How Bitcoin works

To make use of this and any other virtual currency that is on the market we will need to download a software on our computer or on our mobile that will be the "**virtual wallet**" and that will generate a **Bitcoin** address, which can be used to send and receive money from other users.

In addition, the sending of Bitcoin's is instantaneous and every operation can be monitored in real time. Transactions with this currency involve a transfer of value between two public but anonymous **Bitcoin** addresses. To ensure security, transactions are secured using a series of key cryptographies, as each account has a public and a private key.



Where I can get Bitcoin

From the birth of **Bitcoin** to the present day the way to get cryptocurrencies has been greatly simplified, in its beginnings it was tedious to buy and sell **Bitcoin**, but at present it is very simple to be able to obtain cryptocurrencies. From scratch gift cards, to online apps for both your computer and your mobile phone, it's easy to get cryptocurrencies and pay with them.



Today, we even find ATMs everywhere where we can buy and sell our cryptocurrencies, we can find them in hotels, shops, streets and in shopping centres.

Without going any further, here in Torrevieja you have an ATM where it is possible to buy and sell various types of cryptocurrencies such as **Bitcoin**, **Ethereum**, **Dash** and others in the **Habaneras Shopping Centre** on the first floor.

PAY YOUR ACCOUNT WITH CRIPTOCURRENCY

HOW DO I DO IT? 8 simple steps...

Step 1.- Ask the waiter or waitress for your account and tell them that you want to pay for your account with cryptocurrencies.

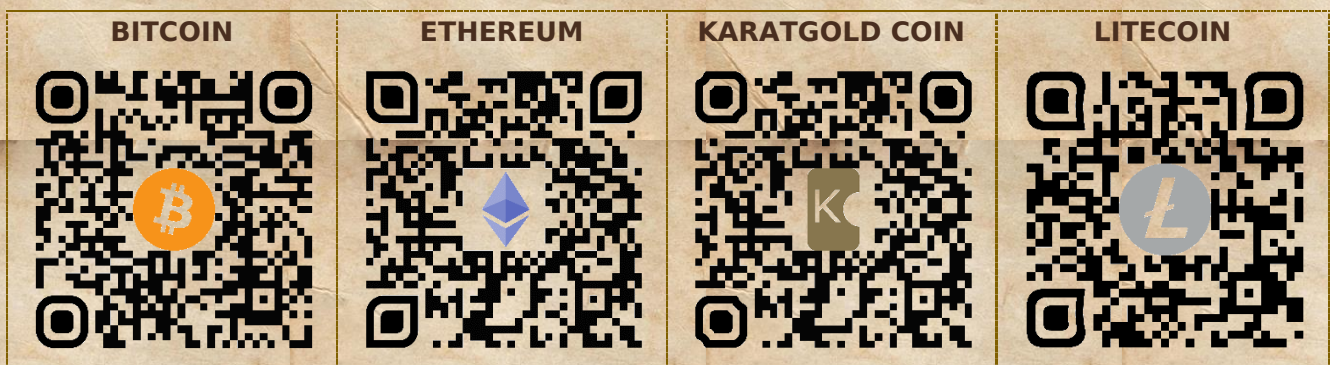
STEP 2.- Open your mobile APP.

STEP 3.- Choose the cryptocurrency with which you want to make the payment (we accept Bitcoin (BTC), Litecoin (LTC),Ethereum(ETH) and Karatgold Coin (KBC).

STEP 4.- Write in your mobile APP the amount of your account.

STEP 5.- Show your waiter or waitress your Mobile APP with the amount of your account once inserted so you can verify it.

STEP 6.- Scan the QR code corresponding to the cryptocurrency with which you want to make the payment.



IMPORTANT: Although the current WALLETT APP identify the type of cryptocurrency address, to avoid scanning the wrong code and lose your funds, we recommend that you cover with one hand the codes that do not correspond to the cryptocurrency with which you will make the payment.

STEP 7.- Make payment for your consumption.

STEP 8.- Show your waiter or waitress that you have paid for your account.
